Virtual Auction Fest Update

Helen Hagan was present to give a report on the Virtual Auction Fest. The committee is still accepting donations. They already have over 50 items to auction. The website went live this weekend, although the auction items are only in preview mode. Bidding will be Oct. 1-24. There are also St. Francis Xavier shirts, ornaments, and tumblers for sale on the site.
