Meeting opened with prayer.

Chairman, Lou Leppert, welcomed new member, Shannon Age, and new alternate, Lisa Reed.

Facilities Board Update/Approval of Rental Agreements:

Mitchell Elder was present to give an update on the new Xavier Center and renovated Parish Hall. The Facilities Board has developed rental agreements/applications for the gymnasium and the meeting room. They gathered input from the Archdiocese and our insurance company to develop the agreements, and asked Steve Tillman, parishioner and attorney, to help revise.

Copies of the agreement contracts were sent to council members for review prior to tonight's meeting.

Bartenders will serve beer and wine for an additional fee. When alcohol is served, we will use security as well.

Use of the kitchen will come with an additional contract and fee, which is still being drafted.

Parish events will not have to pay a rental fee (ex.ministries such as the Women's Bazaar).

Mitchell added that the renovations on the Parish Hall are almost complete. The last thing to be done is to build a kitchen upstairs.

Father Dale thanked Mitchell for his guidance throughout the construction and renovation project.

We have had more than 250 people sign-in for activities in the Xavier Center. Those activities include walking, Tai Chi, pickleball, and men's basketball.

The site inspection of the Xavier Center was done for the liquor license and we are awaiting final approval from the state. The Mt. Washington license has already been approved. These will be in place for the Davenport Dinner.

<u>Parish Life</u>
