


A Summary Of Our Ministries' Success

SFX Outreach Ministries provided emergency assistance to 82 families within our community which totaled \$17,327.62, for basic life-sustainment needs such as Utilities (\$15,188.10), Gift Cards (\$900), Rent (\$300), Cable (\$212.95), School Lunches (\$200), Transportation (\$185.96), Insurance (\$141.10), Internet (\$80), Supplies (\$70.21), Groceries (\$50); provided 30 Christmas Baskets to families in need and referred 8 families to St. Vincent DePaul's Santa Shop♥ Community Ministries Partnership with area churches processed 9,000 requests for assistance ♥ Community Garden Volunteers lovingly grew and donated fresh veggies including: beans, kale, broccoli, tomato and sweet potato **Prayer Blanket Ministry** provided comfort, solace and prayers to those enduring afflictions of the body, mind or spirit. The group made 147 blankets and donated their on hand stock to Hosparus (57), Parish Members (54), OCIA (16), for Bereaved Families (9), and donated 4 Quilts for Parish events **Rosary Makers** provided rosaries for **Baptisms**, Parish **First** Communion Class, the OCIA Program and the Knights of Columbus; provided Holy Spirit key chains and necklaces; sent rosaries to Puerto Rico (75); and donated to SFX Outreach Ministry (\$300); Father John Jude Ministries (\$250); #IGiveCatholic (\$200); SFX Prayer Blanket Ministry (\$100); and the Stewards of Appalachia (\$100) ♥ Women's Club hosted Donut Sunday, the Summerfest Cake Wheel and the Epiphany Breakfast to support the SFX fellowship; and donated to: Parish Hall Tables (\$1690), Stewards of Appalachia (\$1000), AED Machine (\$812), Nursing Home Christmas Bags (\$541), #IGiveCatholic (\$500), Little Way Pregnancy Center (\$500), SFX Garden Tiller (\$403), SFX Garden Ministry (\$400), SFX Prayer Blanket Ministry (\$300), School Christmas Needs (\$233), OCIA Gifts (\$160), SFX SummerFest Gift Card (\$100), Trunk or Treat (\$82), and SFX Altar linens (\$60) ♥ Knights of Columbus gave: SFX (\$5500), Coats for Kids (\$1598), Kentucky Association for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (\$1574), Little Way Pregnancy Center (\$1500), St. Martha Parish (\$500), St. Aloysius Giving Tree (\$300), Heavenly Pennies (\$340), Priest in training (\$300), Redeeming Hope (\$300), Scouting of America Troop 776 (\$300), Vocations (\$202), Handicap Ramp Donation (\$200), KoC State Council Golf Scramble (\$100), Wednesday's Child (\$100), Sitio Ministries (\$100) ♥ Scouting of America (Pack and Troop 776) - 27 youth members and 8 adults performed 200 Service Hours and collected 4,500 food items for the Mount Washington Food Bank during its Scouting For Food project Red Cross Blood Drives resulted in 180 units of donated blood, which projected to save 540 lives!
